

Nursery: Spring 1

Personal, social and emotional development

This term we will continue to build relationships with our friends. We will stick to the knight's code by working together and being kind. We will be taking part in circle time with Jigsaw Jenie exploring how to be a good friend.

Communication and language

Children will be learning lots of different stories and learning new words related to the topic to increase their vocabulary. We will learn lots of different songs and make up actions to go with them.

Literacy

Children will enjoy listening to stories and participate in stories and rhymes. Children will focus on developing their speaking and listening skills and they will focus on listening to the sounds around them.



Maths

This half term children will be exploring 2D shapes. We will be counting gold coins into numbered dragon jars and experiment with number writing.

Expressive arts and design

Children will be using their imagination to make castles from junk modelling. We will become artists and paint pictures of dragons. We'll dress up in royal finery fit for a king and queen and have a royal banquet.

Physical Development

During this half term we will be taking part in gym activities. Children will be exploring different balances and ways of travelling across the equipment. The children will continue to develop their fine motor skills by using scissors, threading, pencil control and learning to do their zips.
