In year 2, we will be doing a topic a term.

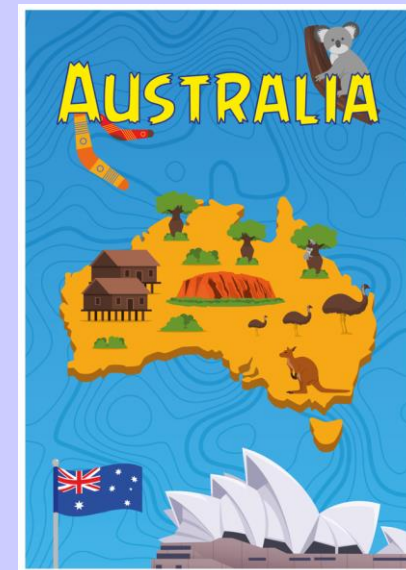

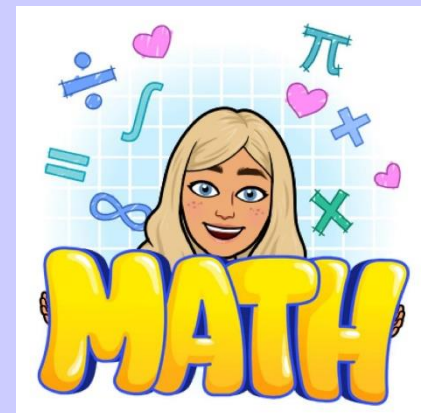

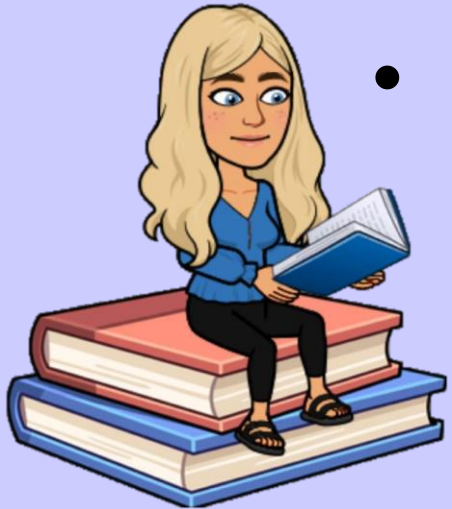
Support with maths

2, 3, 5 and 10 times tables.
 - Number bonds to 10, 20 and 100.
- Reading, writing and ordering numbers to 100.
- Naming and describing 2D and 3D shapes.
 - Recognising coins.



Support with reading

- Read lots of books (magazines, articles, packets, signs, brochures, etc)
- Read out loud Talk about what they have read
- Answer questions about what they have read
 - Name and describe the characters



Support with writing

- Spelling words correctly (common exception words)
 - Forming letters correctly
 - Sitting letters on the line
